We're now the largest local organization focused exclusively on serving homeless families, while keeping families together.

We came together to expand our services to at-risk and homeless families, and to provide residential and community-based services tailored to meet each family's unique needs. As Family Promise, we'll help even more homeless families in Greater Cleveland using best practices to improve our already strong record of success.

Family Promise of Greater Cleveland provides a range of services to meet each family's needs. These include Crisis Intervention, Emergency Housing, Interim Housing combined with employment preparation and job search assistance, and Community-based services once a family moves to housing. Together, we provide over one year of support to help build long-term family stability.
